<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facilities <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students were encouraged to send any issues regarding facilities to Estates estates.helpdesk@dit.ie and the College Officer: astco.cc@tudublinsu.ie. - Broken window handles in rooms 4060 and 4097. - Rooms 4067, 4068 and 5034 are very cold. - Water fountain by the canteen has very weak water pressure. - Canteen is too warm. - VP Welfare noted that a second microwave is due to be installed in common area. - Eduoroam should be accessible for students when using their DIT email studentnumber@mydit.ie login in addition to the TUD one. • Class Issues <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Exam timetables: CO noted that it is usually one month before exams begin. - Brightspace: DT315B issues using platform whereby they could not access it. Appears to be an issue with the fact that faculty's emails are @tudublin.ie and students are @mytudublin.ie. • NSteps <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Additional Class Rep training.
