<p><u>Sports</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ellie from sports spoke at the meeting and discussed low engagement throughout the campuses in sport, she has asked class reps to participate in filling out survey and encourage class to fill it out, they will be emailing, texting and sending surveys out to see what students want in relation to available sports. <p><u>Migration</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Joanne and Ann gave a presentation on moving to Grangegorman, they explained how they are responsible for moving Staff, Students and equipment. They would like feedback from students who have concerns or queries relating to the move in Sept 2020. The buildings moving over are Cathal Brugha Street, Kevin Street, Rathmines and of course Grangegorman students who are already up in Grangegorman but will be moving to the East Quad. FAQ can be found here and the presentation can be found Here. <p><u>Elections 2020</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Deputy President spoke on the coming elections of 2020 and encouraged reps and peers to consider running now. Interested parties should ask students about their TU Dublin experiences and what it is they would like to see change so they can incorporate this into their plans and campaigns. A rep queried the structural change of the union when we all move to GG and the Deputy President advised that the Officers would be discussing this at a Referendum meeting that evening. Referendum polling days will be 19th & 20th February and the count will be 21st February. Election Nomination open 27th February. Nominations close 10th March. Election dates Tues 31st Wed 01st April, the count will take place on the 2nd April. <p><u>Student Union Funding</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pierre spoke about the Student Union Funding and explained it was broken up in each college and each college has its own funding. He explained how we are structured differently across the 3 campuses, City campus, Tallaght and Blanchardstown. There are attempts to join up all the funding together into “one pot” which are ongoing. There have also be “mini threats” to cut the funding to the Students Union.
