The national student survey launched the day of the meeting and is to be held in TU Dublin between the 10th of February and 2nd of March. It is a national survey with local impact for students, which improves the University. This survey is important as it captures student opinions and uses them to help improve TU Dublin. This survey is open to First Years, Final Years and Postgrad Taught students. The main points raised were that Rath students will be in GG by September for classes. A specific number cannot yet be given on lockers however there will be 300 bike spaces – 150 per quad. Public Affairs are working on a focus for central quad from a student perspective. Discussions were held on organising a tour for third year students to GG early as they will have the additional pressure of final year projects and exams when on campus from September.
