Re: Workplan Updates

Dear Student Council,

TU Dublin Students' Union's proposed Workplan (23/24) was presented to Student Council on the 26<sup>th</sup> October for discussion. The following feedback was provided (via the minutes):

1. Culture week was assigned to the VP for Welfare & Equality. However, the PTO for International Students is 'leading' the campaign and requested that this be adjusted.

2. There is no mention of the PTO's in the workplan more broadly

3. Some of the dates are mm/dd, while others are dd/mm, and as such there was a request that this be amended / made consistent.

4. There was a query around campuses being named regarding events (leading to the query of 'no events mentioned in East Quad'), a request to clarify this was made.

This feedback was discussed by the President at the subsequent TUDSU CLG Board on the 3<sup>rd</sup> November. Following on from this, the President (in conjunction with the Operations and Finance Lead), on the 8<sup>th</sup> of November made the following changes:

1. Culture week now includes the Part-Time Officer for International Students i.e., this still falls under the umbrella of 'Welfare + Equality' but is absolutely being lead this year by the PTO for International Students.

2. The PTO's are now mentioned throughout the workplan, where appropriate, which should also help clarify their work for the year.

3. These dates have been amended to be consistent

4. There was an additional line added that now clearly indicates events are across all sites. However, the President confirmed that there is no 'site-specific' items in the workplan (other than the usual Blanchardstown, City, Tallaght).

## <u>Summary</u>

The view of the President is that the workplan now reflects / incorporates all feedback provided at the last Council and would therefore implore Councillors to approve this item.
