Happy New Year! Welcome back councillors and welcome to the new councillors joining us! To refresh you on work to date, I have included a summary below along with a plan for the next few months. Any questions or clarifications, please get in touch, or ask away during the council meeting \bigcirc

Media Outlet

To date:

- Introductory emails to student media publications (Irish and International) to ask for meeting to discuss how
 each publication is run from operational perspective to the staffing structure, resource management (print
 costs/digital costs) etc.
- Research meetings with two Irish student newspapers, 1 Irish student magazine and 1 Finnish student newspaper.
- Research document pulling constitutions/articles/schedules of any SU with a media outlet, looking at editorial board structures, staffing and volunteer contributor structures along with types of sections and popular content.
- Research document presented to TUDSU board of directors outlining options for potential outlet, along with proposal and budget request. Approved and further needs analysis recommended.
- Meetings with key university stakeholders including societies, School of Media and communications to discuss mutual plans and collaboration suggestions.
- Multiple meetings with President to discuss progress and outline resource needs to continue project. Support needs around facilitating student feedback sessions, developing terms of reference for editorial board and recruiting editor.

January 2024:

- Six-month plan worked on with feedback from President and General Manager to decide on key priorities to aid in establishment of media outlet.
- Meetings with school of media to discuss requirements for editorial board and identify potential members. Further discussions include recruitment of editor and support to identify key requirements.
- Primary research (February / March 24)
 - Student Survey coming in February to include questions around student needs in a media outlet, data to inform the development of the outlet.
 - o Student feedback sessions to be arranged to further aid the primary research.
 - Student media crew will be paid to write articles to further identify appetite for student news.
- Terms of reference for media outlet to be presented to the executive, board of directors and student council by end of March 2024.
- Recruitment of editorial board and editor should take place by April 2024.
- Expressions of Interest for contributors in April / May with the view to fill positions by August before Autumn semester commences in September 2024.
