
Keep an eye out for content from student journalists who will be trialing different formats and types of content that we would love you to engage with and feedback on!

An SU election is a vote that happens every year where all students of TU Dublin get to vote for who they would like to lead the TU Dublin Students' Union for the next Academic Year.

#### What is a Referendum?

A Referendum is a direct vote of the students on a key decision or policy of the Union. All students can vote and choose 'Yes' or 'No' and then the TU Dublin SU must follow this decision. This year the Union is holding a referendum on whether TU Dublin SU should remain a part of the Union of Students in Ireland (USI).

# How do I vote?

Find your nearest polling station.

Show your Student Card or Photo ID and collect your Ballot papers.

#### Cast Your Vote:

- Elections: Vote 1 for your favourite candidate, 2 for your second favourite and so on.
- Referendum & Plebiscite: Clearly mark an X on either the 'YES' or 'NO' options.

Put your ballot papers into the ballot box.

That's it! Don't forget to claim your DemocraTea Voucher!


#### WHY?

#### **Mental Health Week**


Mental Health Week is coming up during March 19th-22nd. This semester we'll be focusing on lending a helping hand and educating ourselves on how to support those who are struggling.

There will be a Safetalk training happening on Tuesday the 19th from 9.30am to 13pm in CQ206 (Grangegorman campus). Safetalk is a suicide alertness training that provides skills to enable individuals to support those with suicidal thoughts. The training will be run by 3Ts and is capped at 30 participants, so if you're interested register here!

An online workshop will also be available this week from Niteline. This video workshop is prerecorded to be there when you need it and focuses on Supporting a Friend.
